We are doing fine, although it has been very hot and humid over the summer. In fact we are still in the high 30's.

Aron has returned to the UK and has found work in north London and is working there.

He is hoping to move in to accommodation, and pray that he finds a good church.

Joel is busy sorting out his application process for two years studies in Tirana, and Tomas is awaiting notification next week of where he could study psychology.

Please continue to pray for Joel and Tomas. Neither are baptised, but both were very active with the kids in the summer program, and Tomas continues to organise a weekly sports event with the kids.

The summer period was particularly busy with kids and youth work.

we had over 20 at a 12-14's camp in south of Albania.

Over 70 for two weeks at our holiday bible club and 8 students at the student camp.

We were delighted that 5 girls made professions at the 12-14's camp. two were from our church plant in Lezhe and three from our church.

This was such an encouragement to our prayers and Elida has started a discipleship class with five of our older girls in the group.

Colin is about to start up a discipleship study with a young man in the church, and our only young man at the moment. The only other has gone through some problems and is only about to return to church and again Colin will have to meet him to do a special study as he has serious anger issues.

We were also encouraged with the appointment of two church leaders in Lezhe and Colin will be meeting with them once a month to do a study together and for encouragement as they settle into their roles as elders. We continue to support them in their rent for their church.

We are glad to say that the nursery has managed to cover the teaching posts for the coming year, God willing and a good number of children are registered. We still have 5 spaces, but we are happy with the number registered so far.

Please pray for our application to change the nursery head teacher. In truth, one of our believers who worked 40 years in a government run nursery is our head, but at the moment it is a woman who is ill and wants to leave. At the moment because of red tape, we are having problems just knowing how to make the application. There appears to be no method of making the application and some have said we would have to re-apply for a new licence, which we do not want to do. Please pray that we can find a way and make the change with no difficulty to the function of the nursery.

Colin will be starting, God willing a study on Jeremiah until the end of the year. Please continue to pray for help and good health as he leads and teaches each week.
