As we slowly emerged out of lockdown restrictions it was great to be able to be more regular at my local open-airs. However, we suddenly seem to have exploded into lots of activity again and I find myself running all over the country, and in a situation where I'm explaining to the local open-air team members that I'll not be there next week, and sometimes that's been a case of I'll not be there for the next two weeks.

On the plus side of that, I have been able to be on the OAM teams. In Yorkshire, a lady called Sandy told me that she heard the gospel when she was 14 years old at an open-air in Ascot in 1969. She still has the tract she was given even although it was another 30 years before she became a Christian.





In Tissington we had over 1200 visit our presentation and about 300 John's Gospels were received. Marie-Anne runs the craft fair during Well Dressing and she asked me what I do the rest of the year. An hour-long gospel conversation followed that question!





In Tinshill we had 350 children plus 40 adults came round the exhibition. Some days were in the church as usual, and one day we took the exhibition to a school that had never seen the exhibition before.





As a surprise extra, I had three afternoons with the Faith Mission Students in Edinburgh to give them some practical experience of open-air work. They were very responsive and some preached and attracted an audience to listen to them. Several worthwhile conversations took place.





At Teen Ranch I spoke to the Staff before breakfast, and the campers for two sessions later in the day.





Glasgow went well with good weather for open-airs, people listening to the preaching, and many gospel conversations taking place. When Aiden and Freya came to wish me happy birthday (even although it wasn't my birthday!) I told them about being born again.







I've also been twice to Kirkcaldy, Fife. The first visit I did some training on open-airs followed by an open-air in the town centre and the second time we had the open-air first and then a deputation meeting in a local Baptist Church. I was encouraged at the response of local Christians and at the general public in standing to listen to the preaching and engage in conversation.
