We've also been encouraged in Kilmarnock recently as a local taxi driver came along. He stopped for a chat as we were setting up the board and said he'd come back after he visited the bank. Somewhat sceptically, I thought we'd probably never see him again. However, he came back and listened to my message. And he's been back every week since! He brings his coffee and sits on the bench to listen to the gospel. We usually chat before and after the preaching. Pray that our taxi driving friend would come to saving faith in Christ.

Our weekly visits to Ayr (photo on the right) have continued to be lively. We frequently have people make loud comments as they pass by and some stop to interact as they heckle the preacher. We also still have our regular listeners who normally spend their time in the turf accountant's office right next to where we stand. One man frequently comes out and stands at the door while another will come and sit on one of the benches.



We also had some interesting characters in Falkirk. The gentleman with his back to us in the photo on the left was not happy with Richard's preaching. He asked us if we would



like to give the preacher a bat on the mouth! When we told him that the preacher is our friend he slowly made his way over towards him and aggressively told Richard that he was in the way. Richard neatly sidestepped and continued his message while our unhappy man continued slowly along the street.

Please keep on praying for the lost. Pray too for more workers. We're encouraged that there has been more interest in open-air work among the Lord's people and we are doing what we can to build on that. We're also looking at some new ventures in Scotland, including Edinburgh and in the Highlands. Pray on, that the Lord of the harvest will thrust forth labourers into the field.
