

Dear brother William,

Warm Christian greetings,

Please express to the dear believers in Barrhead assembly our sincere thanks for the kind gift of £xxx.xx received via LWT and as from the Lord. We are very touched by your love and thoughtfulness in this expression of fellowship which is much appreciated to support us, as we further advance the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Your sacrificial giving is a great encouragement to us as we serve the Lord together. We give God thanks and feel so unworthy but richly blessed by the evidence of God's rich mercy towards us.

We know there are so many different and varied needs arise every week in the orphanages and through your sacrifice we will be able to help with some of these needs. Also it will be great to help to buy food for the "homeless shelter", next time brother Ruslan goes to preach the Gospel there.

At the end of September, I was invited to the assembly in Mechelen, Belgium where I had a couple of Gospel meetings. The assembly had already distributed invitations in the district for a Gospel meeting each Saturday and Sunday night. I also shared some ministry and gave a report on our recent visit to Lviv, Ukraine. It was a joy another time to fellowship with the saints there and appreciated their effort in the Gospel.

We have designed and printed 15,000 Ukrainian Gospel calendars for distribution in Ireland amongst the thousands of refugees! We would value your prayers for this exercise that God's Word will be blessed in the salvation of souls.

Last week we sent by courier 5,000 calendars to different cities and towns in Northern and Southern Ukraine like Sumy and Odessa, we also printed a further 5,000 in Lviv.

On Friday 7th November we arranged a Ukrainian Gospel meeting in Moville, Co Donegal, with translation, and the help of the Letterkenny assembly. We would value your prayers that God's blessing would be upon the Gospel and that many may be saved to God's glory. We were really encouraged when 20 Ukrainian refugees arrived at the meeting and listened carefully to the simple message spoken from 1 Timothy 1:15. We also had a further 20 British/Irish people at the meeting so we had some singing in Ukrainian and English, which went reasonably well! We rounded off the evening with some tasty refreshments and each Ukrainian going home with some good Gospel literature.

We give God thanks that we were able to visit Ukraine in February, and also in June/July 2025. Things on the ground are not easy and the people are weary and tired after so much stress and worry of the unknown, about tonight and tomorrow as the war and these horrible attacks continue. We can only look to the Sovereign Lord to bring lasting and enduring PEACE!

We attach for your prayerful interest our last update from Lviv.

We trust all in the assembly keep well and may God bless you all richly.
