

Dear Friends in the Lord,

Regarding the sale of the property at Voice of the Gospel ministries we are still awaiting what should be the final outcome. If the buyer hasn't come up with any payment by the 6th of July then the sales agreement should be cancelled. He has said that he will come up with the money so we'll just have to wait and see. We will let you know what transpires.

All the regular activities at the church have now stopped for the summer. We had a final presentation last Sunday of the Sunday School work and we had all the children and young people up the front and had special time of prayer for them.

The activities over the year include : Literacy classes for Arab women twice a week; Alpha courses and Alpha couples' courses; Activities with the 'Oasis' group (for ex-Muslims and those with a Muslim background); Sunday School for children aged 0-3, for pre-school children aged 4-6, for primary school children aged 6-11. A young teens group for ages 12-14, a youth group for ages 15-18 and a young adults group for ages 19-30. There is also a ladies meeting, an arts class, a dance and worship class and quite a few home groups which run in different areas in and around the town of Aix-en-Provence. There have also been special activities such as the fun day previously mentioned and car boot sale. We praise the Lord for a time of blessing during these activities and we do pray that what has been shared will be a blessing to all those who attended these different activities. We pray too that the Lord will guard and protect each one during the summer period. Some activities are already planned for when the school takes up again in September.

This Saturday 6th we are having a musical evening with a singer from Canada and he will be accompanied by two other musicians. He is a full time worker in Canada and has an interesting testimony. We pray for a time of blessing during this evening.

On Tuesday 9th the final signing for the flat we are buying for the full time worker will take place. Everything has gone smoothly for the buying of this flat and the Lord has provided for it. Now, it will be a case of doing work on it to get it ready for the couple arriving in September. The flat will be rewired and we have hired an electrician to do this but there will also be the laying of new floor coverings throughout and decoration work which we will do ourselves. We pray that all of this will go smoothly too and that the necessary labour force will come forward.

A wedding will take place on Saturday 27th. A young couple, he from Syria and part of the 'Oasis' group and his fiancée a missionary/teacher from the States will say 'Yes' to one another. We do pray that the wedding will be a good testimony to the Lord's glory as many people will be present who are not believers.
