As in all the world, Assembly life has undergone great changes; most adapting to "Zoom" meetings which are filling a gap and satisfying present needs. Everybody longs to physically meet together but this still seems a way off yet. Consultations are many and commitments much more too, since no long hours of travel are involved. Quite recently I spoke in Orán 800 miles away for a long weekend. It was lovely to meet by Zoom with the Robertson family. I have made two "visits" to help the dear saints In Encarnación, Paraguay, where I have visited several times. The work has grown considerably there and the assembly is now building a simple but practical meeting place. Pictures looks a bit like Nehemiah chapter three with the women and children involved too.

Please pray for this weekend 18-20^{th.} September; I will be returning to our roots in Argentina in Posadas for their Conferences; this time no 10 hour bus journeys each way are needed. However, I would gladly do it as nothing can replace the warmth and the wealth of the gatherings of the Lord's people and off the platform fellowship. So often we have proven that over a long weekend the biggest needs have been those met privately or with local elders.

In Paraná all meetings are held by Zoom. As with pre- COV19 physical meetings our main concern is for those who cannot "connect" and more so, for some who don't or are inconsistent.

My grandson Ivan has a weekly two hour secular programme on a highly rated FM Radio. He was able to include his Dad, my son in law Heber, with a 5 minute spot in which he presents a hymn it's author and background story with a gospel application. The owner of the Radio was impressed by the quality of the programme and offered Heber a five minute spot at 9pm every night which will be paid for. It will be called "Yesterdays Hymns with Echoes of Eternity" He already has "Hymns and their Writers" by Jack Strahan. Argentina has the longest quarantine in the world; 178 days today. Despite that cases are not decreasing. Yesterday Sunday saw the largest country wide demonstrations held pacifically by the middle and upper class in repudiation of political opportunism, the recent release of some 6000 big time crooks and delinquents, suggested changes to the Constitution; especially to the Judicial System which rather than be independent would be managed and judges named by the present government. It virtually means more corruption, and that government can control and manage everything.

On the family front we live close to the COVID19 Virus. My daughter Anne's husband Marcelo and her son Brian both work as Doctors in Rosario Hospitals.
