We are continually asked and invited to revisit our former decades long known brothers and sisters in Asia and China. With no passport and a very difficult replacement process in progress, we know the Lord has clearly said – "Not Yet!" so China, Beijing, Xian, Hong Kong, Korea, Burma, Vietnam and Fiji are all on the list but currently on "standby."

We are often caringly asked, "How has it really been to relocate?" Our usual reply has been – "not easy, actually quite tough but valuable lessons have been ours as we continue to believe, trust and depend upon our most Wonderful Lord and Master. "We live by faith and not by sight. Without faith it is impossible to please GOD." Thankfully we have been granted exceptional health, strength and energy to continue to be of some use to the Lord and to be wherever He chooses to place us.
